Since we last wrote we've been a little busy. We thought we'd take some time to bring everyone up to speed on recent family and ministry events.

MINISTRY NEWS:

● The new work our Mother Church helped start in Villa El Salvador turned 1 year old. They celebrated by starting a new work of their own some ten minutes away.

● We conducted a 2 month long Spiritual Growth Campaign in the Mayorazgo church which produced tremendous results among our people.

● A group of 60 people from our sending church, FBC of Vilonia, Arkansas came for a visit. During their time here we were able to take a trip to Pisco to visit the new work of BBFI missionary Brent Williams, hold dental clinics, carry out evangelistic efforts in Santa Clara and Villa El Salvador; also holding a clothes/toy drive for the children of these areas. We were also able to enter more than a dozen Public Schools presenting the Gospel to around 10,000 young people. One tangible result of the trip was the salvation of Betty, for whom we've been praying for about 2 ½ years. Many of the ladies from the group visited the jewelry shop she owns, and they too began praying for her. The Sunday following the group's departure Betty put her faith in Jesus Christ!

● The new church plant in Santa Clara also celebrated its one year anniversary. The work there is going well.

● The Mayorazgo church held its first annual Missions Conference. As a result we have seen an increase in Missions giving and a collective buzz around the church about missions work.

● Our youngest, Kyra, fell down several stairs, fracturing her collarbone. After a week in a sling you could hardly tell. ☺
